RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR PARENTS

1. Parents/Guardian should read and understand the rules and regulations governing admission and must be responsible at all times for their child/children.
2. Registration fee of \$20 should be paid to their centers at the time of submission of Registration Form. No refund of registration fee.
3. All Registrations must be done through the respective centers only.
4. All information should be filled up in the registration form.
5. Last date for Registration – March 1st, 2009. Registrations will NOT BE accepted after this date.
6. All participants must report at 10:00 AM in the specified venue.
7. All participants must be accompanied by their parents/guardians.
8. Parents/guardians must be present in the premises at all times.
9. Parents/guardians are not allowed inside the Examination Hall.
10. Competition will be conducted in a separate hall.
11. At the time of the competition, PARENTS/GUARDIANS MUST BE INSIDE THE AUDITORIUM and are not allowed going out.
12. Students must bring their Admit Card. Students WITHOUT the Admit Card will NOT BE allowed to participate in the competition.
13. Students must bring their own ABACUS, 2 pencils and an eraser.
14. ALOHA USA and their staff are not responsible for any loss, damage of your valuables.
15. All the participants should be medically fit to participate in the competition.
16. ALOHA USA's decision is final.
17. Snacks will be sold in the premises.
18. No food or drink will be allowed inside the auditorium.

Classification of categories & levels

Category:

Children will be classified into 4 categories based on their age/program as below:

Category	Age Group
A	Below 8
B	8 and 9 years
C	10 and Above
D	ALOHA Junior(irrespective of age)

Note:

Only completed age as of March 1st, 2009 will be considered. E.g. If Child is 7 years and 6 months old, the child will be in 'A' Category.

Level:

Competition will be held for all the levels. Students will compete for the current level whatever they are in, as of March 1st 2009. ALOHA Junior will be competing only under Category D.
